Types of Individual Membership

Regular Member: For professionals interested in the field of mathematics.

Postgraduate Member: 50% discount off the price of regular membership for the first three years after graduation and 25% discount off the price of regular membership for the fourth and fifth years after graduation.

Student Member: For full-time students enrolled in any college or university who are studying mathematics, engineering, computer science, physical science, or who use mathematics or computational methods in any field of study. Free or discounted memberships.

Retired Member: For those who have been SIAM Regular Members in good standing for at least 15 years who retire from employment. Reduced rate.

Outreach Member: For residents of developing countries. Greatly discounted rate. **NEW!** Residents of China now have the option of paying in local currency.

Associate Member: For spouses of Regular Members. Reduced rate.

Lifetime Member: Prepay your membership and never have to pay dues again.

Reciprocal Member: For individuals residing outside of the United States who belong to another mathematical society with which SIAM has a reciprocity agreement. Discounted rate.

Unemployed or Disabled: For renewing Regular Members who become unemployed or disabled. Discounted rate.

How to Join

Graduate students (Master's and Ph.D. candidates) who attend an institution that is an Academic Member of SIAM can join SIAM for free. These memberships can be renewed for up to six years as long as the member remains a student at an eligible school.

To apply online: Go to SIAM Web Services to create a new customer record, receive your username and password, and then join online.

To apply by postal mail or fax: Download an application.

Undergraduate students who attend an institution that is an Academic Member of SIAM can be nominated for complimentary membership by any regular SIAM member in good standing or by their department chair in mathematics, engineering, computer science, physical science, or any field of study using mathematics or computational methods. Nominations can be made by e-mailing the student's name, shipping address, and e-mail address to liberatore@siam.org. Nominators should notify students that they have been nominated for a complimentary SIAM membership.

Student members of SIAM student chapters will receive free student memberships in SIAM. To receive free memberships, faculty advisor or chapter officer can send the list of student chapter members to Membership Manager Susan Whitehouse, including student name, mailing address, e-mail address, and whether each member is a graduate or undergraduate student.

Any SIAM Regular Member in good standing can nominate up to two students per year for membership in SIAM. Fill in and submit the online nomination form.

Benefits of Free Student Membership

Benefits of free student membership are the same as for regular student members, except that free student members are not eligible to vote in SIAM elections and only receive SIAM Review in electronic format.
